I am requesting funding for Homewood House - Housing Authority of the City of Pittsburgh in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Housing Authority of the City of Pittsburgh, located at 412 Boulevard of the Allies, Pittsburgh, PA 15219. The funding would be used for rehabilitation of Homewood House for the purpose of affordable housing preservation including immediate capital improvements to address structural deficiencies, hazardous mold, and failing mechanical systems, ensuring long-term safety and housing stability for its low-income senior residents.
