
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Increasing Resiliency and Security of Raw Water Intake System in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority, located at 1200 Penn Avenue Pittsburgh, PA 15222. The funding would be used to complete a comprehensive rehabilitation of two raw water intake structures at the water treatment plant. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the intakes are more than 100 years old and are severely deteriorated, these conditions expose Pittsburgh Water, the community and many regional institutions to water service disruption risks.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
