
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Allegheny County Multi-Municipal Storm/Sanitary Rehabilitation Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Allegheny County, located at 436 Grant Street Pittsburgh, PA 15219. The funding would be used to repair and rehabilitate aging sewer infrastructure to reduce wet weather overflow to both the Conveyance System and the Wastewater Treatment Facilities which become overloaded during intense storms. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will combat sewage infiltration into storm water system, thereby diverting sewage from entering local rivers.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
