I am requesting funding for "Turtle Creek Flood Protection Project" (TCLFCP) in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Allegheny County Department of Public Works, located at County Office Building, 542 Forbes Ave, Pittsburgh, PA 15219.

The funding would be used for the following activities: 1.) removal of debris from a failed private wall; 2.) stabilizing hillside; 3.) relocating sediment from a section of the TCLFCP; and making improvements at the Ardmore Debris Basin.
